### Scam Alert !

One of the latest scams to be doing the rounds is an email attempting to blackmail you into paying money in bitcoin in order to prevent compromising or embarrassing information being released to the public or your contacts.

They may use a password of your's in order to provide credibility to their threat, but this is usually on old password that is no longer in use.

This email gives the impression of being personally directed at you, however it is computer generated en masse with the idea that thousands of emails will result in enough people paying to make it worthwhile for the scammer.
