No matter what you are using to go camping, keep in mind that it is not as secure as your home.

### Before you leave

Check the id number of the chassis, consider fitting a safe for your valuables. Ensure items of value have id marks engraved. Keep an inventory of fixtures such as microwaves and refrigerators.

### At the Camping Ground

Get to know your neighbours and keep an eye on each other's property. Don't leave items lying about that can be easily taken. Chain or padlock items to your vehicle or store safely in park facilities. Don't leave washing outside overnight.

### When Away From Your Camp

Lock valuables in a safe or out of sight such as in the boot of your vehicle. Always lock your caravan, even if only going for a short time. Avoid having your caravan or site appear as if no one is there. Leave on a light, or radio, use timers etc. Advise the park manager or neighbouring campers you trust, that you will be away for an extended time and leave contact details.



### Crime Report Crime report for September 2020

- Never hide keys outside. Potential offenders know where to look.
- Never leave your vehicle unlocked or with the key in the ignition.
- Don't leave items of value visible in a vehicle, eg the laptop sitting on the back seat, iPod or iPads in the centre console and thieves will break windows to get to your parking meter change.
- Secure your property. When you are not using something, store it away - bikes in the garage, tools in the shed. Criminals look for easy opportunities and theft takes but a few seconds.
